Bourse Chair Named for World Stamp Show-NY 2016

Show President Wade Saadi has appointed **Tami Jackson** as Chair of World Stamp Show-NY 2016 dealer bourse. "Tami is currently Advertising and Administration Director of **The ASD&C** and has had extensive experience in helping ASDA dealers maximize their sales through her business skills," Saadi said. "She is the perfect person to help dealers maximize their profitability at World Stamp Show-NY 2016."

Working with Tami is Andy Kupersmit, serving as Dealer Consultant, and Steven J. Rod, Executive Director of WSS-NY 2016. All serve on the Show organizing Committee as well.

This once-a-decade U.S. international philatelic exhibition will take place Sat., May 28 through Sat., June 4, 2016, at the Jacob Javits Convention Center in New York City, the East Coast's largest convention center. Nearly 300,000 square feet in an open expanse with a 33-foot ceiling have been reserved for the event.

"I'm looking forward to this opportunity to make this show a great success," Jackson noted. "We already have advance deposits from more than 70 dealers from the United States and around the world. With slightly more than 200 dealer booths available, we anticipate a sellout within the next nine months. I will be contacting all of our ASDA members throughout the summer about joining this extravaganza, and we are extending invitations to all of the international dealers who attended Washington 2006."

"We are excited to have Tami join the WSS-NY 2016 team, having watched her bring a sound and useful business plan to both the ASDA and **ASD&C**. We know we will benefit greatly from her experience as she reaches out to the dealer community," noted Rod.

Dealer pre-registration continues on a first-come basis with a \$1,000 refundable deposit. A variety of booth sizes and configurations at an assortment of price points will be available for dealers who pre-register, with priority based on their registration date. Booth layouts will be announced in the upcoming months after the selection of a decorator has been made.
