For the first time this spring, the French Postal Service ([La Poste française](#)), represented by [Phil@poste](#), will be present at the [World Stamp Show - NY 2016](#). The show, which will take place at the Jacob K. Javits Convention Center in Manhattan from Saturday, May 28 through Saturday, June 4, 2016, will feature over 150 stamp dealers, 50 postal bureaus, several lectures and ceremonies, and even a "Beginner Pavilion."

The show will have an international slant this year and will include exhibits from over 75 countries. International stamp exhibitions of this kind have been held only once per decade and began in 1926.
