## World Stamp Show-NY 2016 Appointments Made

WSS-NY 2016 is pleased to announce the appointment of Stephen D. Schumann of Hayward, CA as the exhibition's Commissioner General and Tami Jackson of Leesport, PA as Bourse Chair.

Mr. Schumann will act as the primary liaison between the show and some 80 representatives from all over the world who will be transporting and mounting exhibits on behalf of their nation's exhibitors and act as spokespersons for their national philatelic organizations.

Steve brings a wealth of experience to the position. He is a well known exhibitor and judge, acting as either commissioner or juror to 16 international stamp exhibitions since 1990 and currently serves as Chairman of the APS International Committee wherein he directs all activities of U.S. appointees to FIP Commissions and APS Commissioners and Judges to international exhibitions.

His own exhibits have won numerous gold medals at national and international competitions, specializing in the postal stationery of North Borneo, Sarawak, Brunei and New Zealand from the British Empire and Commonwealth. He has been a Grand Award winner at several national shows.

Steve is currently General Chairman and Jury Coordinator of San Jose's WSP annual exhibition, "Filatelic Fiesta." He has served on over 30 national level juries in various capacities, including Chief Philatelic and Chief Literature Judge.

A second key appointment is that of Tami Jackson of Leesport, PA as Bourse Chair. She along with her husband, Eric, currently manages Eric Jackson Stamps, one of America's largest specialists in revenue philately. She also continues to handle the business affairs and accounting for the American Stamp Dealers Association, with additional responsibility as advertising director for the "American Stamp Dealer & Collector" magazine since its inception at the Washington 2006 International Stamp Exhibition.

Tami worked for Amos Press from 1986 to 1999 beginning in the accounting department, eventually assuming the posts of administrator and then controller. In 1997 she joined the Linn's Stamp News team to work in advertising sales for Michael Laurence.

Tami earned an Associate's Degree in business with a minor in accounting while working full time and raising 3 children.
