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Organizations Welcome at World Stamp Show-NY 2016

Philatelic societies and clubs may now apply for booth space and meeting rooms at World Stamp Show-NY 2016, taking place May 28-June 4, 2016 at the Jacob Javits Convention in New York City. Details are online at <http://www.ny2016.org>.

A total of 59, 10x10 foot booths are available at the philatelic exhibition to showcase and promote these organizations. Each booth contains two 8 foot long skirted tables (one front and one rear), five chairs and a waste basket, surrounded by 3 foot high "pipe and drape" sides with an 8 foot high backdrop and identifying sign.

All booths are required to be staffed a minimum of 7 hours each day by at least one person on all 8 days of the show. Two groups may share a booth.

Booth holders may also reserve rooms during the exhibition for meetings and seminars. Participating societies have the opportunity to create a sixteen page display promoting their organizations. These frames will be located elsewhere on the floor, not in booths.

Societies may participate at one of three levels: Patron (\$1,000), Organizer (\$500), or Sponsor (\$250). It is anticipated that larger societies will participate at the Patron level, while others will join at either the Organizer or Sponsor level.

"Super Booths" measuring 20x10 foot formed from two adjacent booths are available on a limited basis for \$2,000. Please inquire if interested.

A minimum \$250 deposit reserves a booth, with the balance due by January 1, 2016. The Show catalog will prominently list participating organizations, indicating the level of participation, with Patron level participants receiving a half-page display ad at no additional cost.

Requests for space for meetings and seminars are being accepted from booth holders at this time. Priority for use of space will be based on the level of participation and then on a first come basis.
